## Course Superintendent

Course – Harlan Golf & Country Club is a semi-private, 9-hole golf course in southwest Iowa on Highway 59 in-between Omaha and Des Moines. Our course is over 100 years old with many tall trees that offer fun, but a challenge to the golfer. We offer a great clubhouse with a restaurant and full bar. We also have putting and chipping greens and a driving range.

Job Description – The golf course superintendent will be responsible for operating and maintaining the golf course. Some of the responsibilities include: agronomy maintenance and turf grass management, pesticide applications and record keeping, maintaining irrigation system, equipment maintenance, work independently to solve problems, and managing part-time summer employees. The superintendent will report to the Board and work closely with the Clubhouse Manager.

### Primary Duties

- Operate and maintain the golf course in a fiscal manner.
- Manage the agronomy and chemical applications and maintain accurate recordkeeping.
- Manage the irrigation system.
- Manage and supervise part-time employees regarding course maintenance.
- Perform general maintenance to equipment.
- Ability to work well with others efficiently while working around member and tournament play.
- Work with the Board on budget and supplies needed.
- Attend monthly Board meetings with updates.

### Qualifications and Compensation

- Salary is based on experience – range from \$35,000-\$45,000. Housing may be included.
- Experience in turf grass management.
- Pesticide application license or ability to obtain one.
- Golfing and social privileges included.
- Discounted food during working hours.
- Valid driver's license.
